


















Department of Business

Close ties with the economy: innovative solutions for businesses



The projects concentrate on topics such as health promotion, prevention and rehabilitation, as well as the entire human life cycle – from birth through to professional care in old age. Chronic conditions are another focus area.

Our research centres on the distinct perspectives and needs of all those affected – be it clients and their relatives or the various health experts involved. Another priority is finding ways to involve patients and doctors in evaluations.






